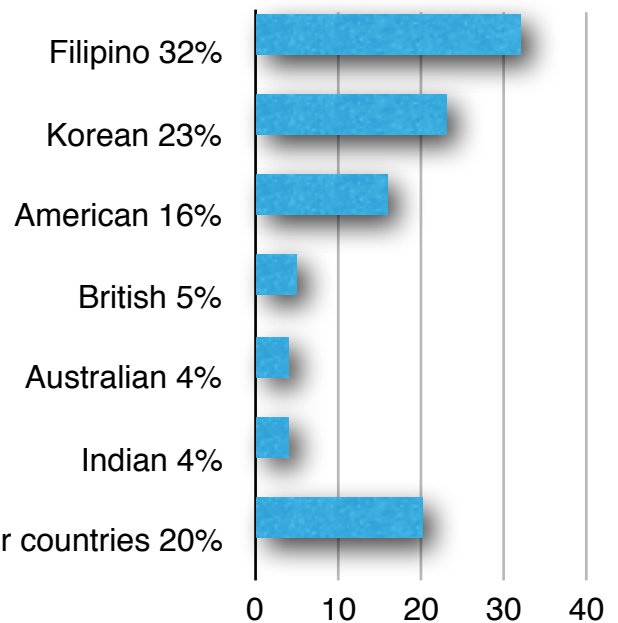

Grade 11 and 12 Curriculum

All students in Grades 11 and 12 take at least six classes, one course from each of the groups listed below. In addition, they take Junior Seminar in the first semester of Grade 11 and Theory of Knowledge (TOK) in the second semester of Grade 11 and first semester of Grade 12. They also are to participate in after school activities/clubs and community service outreach at least once a semester. Successful completion of these courses and requirements over the last two years of study qualifies a student for one of two different Brent School diplomas (Brent Diploma or Brent Honors Diploma).

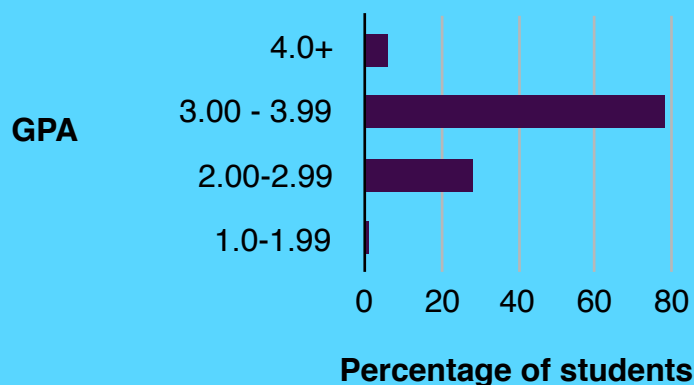
