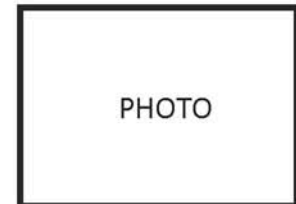

TERMS OF STUDENT ACTIVITY CONTRACT

ELIGIBILITY

- 1) Participation in Brent athletic teams and/or other extracurricular activities is a privilege.
- 2) All students at Brent are eligible to try out for any school sponsored sport or activity
- 3) All those wishing to participate in any school sport or activity or are on any student council must complete a student Activity Contract. Students who do not comply with this requirement may be suspended from further participation until the contract is completed.
- 4) **Students on Academic Warning or Academic Probation** may be ineligible to participate in extracurricular activities.
- 5) **The rules listed in the Parent-Student Handbook** must be followed. In addition and as a reminder, the following are not allowed. Consumption or possession of the following:
 - a. Smoking or vaping
 - b. Tobacco or tobacco products
 - c. Illicit or illegal substances
 - d. Inhaling of muscle spray or similar substances
 - e. Any products containing alcohol, liquor or intoxicating substancesIn addition to established consequences at Brent, students who are in violation of the above, may be suspended from the activity or council and could be declared ineligible for all activities for up to one year.
- 6) **Drug violations:** A student may be ineligible for up to one full year and will be subject to established Brent disciplinary action.
- 7) **Bullying/Initiations:** Any student who is involved in bullying, initiation, hazing or other similar activities may be immediately removed from the roster of any sport or activity in which he or she is currently engaged and additional sanction and consequences may be applied. Any student who has knowledge of such activities can also be subjected to consequences, sanctions, and possible removal from a sports roster if they fail to report the bullying or hazing.
- 8) Students, who show recalcitrance with regards to their academic work, school rules, general behavior, attention to their responsibilities, etc., may also be subjected to suspension from the sports or activity.

VIOLATIONS

Students who contravene or offend against items 4, 5, or 6 under eligibility during the season or activity period will automatically forfeit all rights to receive school letters, MVP, All Star, and any other awards the activity may offer.

ACCIDENT INSURANCE COVERAGE

It is the responsibility of the student's parent/s to ensure that students are covered with comprehensive health insurance during their time at Brent School. Should an accident occur on school property or during a school related event, any inquiries relating to this accident should be directed to the Brent Clinic.

UNIFORMS

The School will pay 50% of the basic uniform. This does not include t-shirts, jackets, sweatshirts, footwear, bags, etc. The rest of the cost of the team uniform will be charged to the student. Any practice uniforms or special equipment that may be issued from time to time must be returned or the replacement cost will be charged to the student.

FINE ARTS PRODUCTIONS

Any costumes / materials that are provided by the school must be laundered and returned. If not, then the replacement cost and / or the laundering of such items will be charged to the student.

BUS TRIPS

This contract includes consent for the bus trips when games or activities are held off campus. Students must travel to and from off-campus venues in school-approved transportation. Students may return with their parents or drivers provided prior written or verbal permission is conveyed to the coach or sponsor.

QUITTING A TEAM

If a student quits a team, then he or she shall be ineligible for the duration of that season, and shall not be allowed to try out for, or become a member of, any other team until the team he or she quit has completed its season. The student will also be required to pay 100% of any uniform costs.

AWARDS

Participants in those activities for which awards are given (e.g. Varsity sports awards, activity school letters, etc.) should check with the coach concerned and the Director for Student Activities for complete details on each activity and exact requirements for the various awards.

DRESS CODE

- 1) In activities requiring uniforms, all participants are expected to wear the official school uniform in competition. During practice, students are expected to abide by the appropriate dress requirements and guidelines provided by the Student Activities Office.

- 2) Students traveling to off-campus locations are expected to dress appropriately. The Students Activities Office will provide guidelines.

SUPERVISION

Students should not use any facility, especially the Fitness Center, without proper adult supervision.

SOCIAL MEDIA

Inappropriate use of social media may result in disciplinary action.

ABSENCES

A student who has an unexplained absence even in one (1) class will not be allowed to participate in any after school activity on the same day or on a subsequent day, if necessary.

VISITING TEAM HOUSING

All members of the Varsity and Junior Varsity Teams and members of APAC Activity Groups are required to provide housing for at least two visiting students during an APAC event or non APAC events which require "home stay" housing by Brent students. This includes other activities, which require housing by Brent. This is not restricted to the event in which the student is involved.

STUDENTS BEHAVIORAL EXPECTATIONS:

All students trying out and selected for a team must:

- 1) Fill out and sign a Student activity Contract;
- 2) Follow coaches' rules and regulations;
- 3) Conduct themselves with dignity, sportsmanship, and fair play;
- 4) Maintain good study habits and academic standings;
- 5) Be prompt and attend practice sessions and games at all times. Exceptions: Health and Academic.
- 6) Respect authority of program directors, coaches, and sports officials;
- 7) Maintain a high level of physical fitness consistent with success in the sport or activity;
- 8) Respect the feeling of peers and their personal belongings;
- 9) Show proper use and care of equipment;
- 10) Schedule personal appointments at a time that is least disruptive to team commitments;
- 11) Use appropriate attitude and language in communicating with coaches, activities staff, opponents, spectators and peers;
- 12) Refrain from taking or using restricted substances during the season, including alcohol, tobacco products and drugs;
- 13) Advise coaches and / or the Student Activities Office in advance when a requirement cannot be met.
